Airborne Survey Results

Stewart Project, British Columbia

Auramex Resource Corp. (the "Company") announces that it has received from Geotech Ltd., results from the helicopter flown VTEM-M Survey that covered approximately one-third of the Company's properties in the Stewart, BC, area. The results appear encouraging but the Company will be retaining a consultant with specific expertise in the interpretation of geophysical data. Additionally the Company has two consulting geologists who will assemble other data for incorporation into a comprehensive model. For example, assays taken in the past three years, historical information from published third party sources, government generated maps, etc., will be incorporated.

Geotech states "based on the geophysical results obtained, a number of EM anomalies were identified across the property. The magnetic results may also contain worthwhile information in support of exploration targets of interest . . ."

A 9.5 square kilometre area was flown at the Tide North Property 40 kilometres north of Stewart. Geotech states in part as follows: "In the central part of the block the VTEM results have defined a conductive zone . . . the conductive zone is represented by a horizontal (stratiform) layer which lies at ~ 70m depth."

At the Bear Property, 939 line kilometres were flown in areas ranging from 8 to 30 kilometres from Stewart. Geotech states, in part, as follows: "Block 4 hosts various conductive zones . . . Morphologically the conductive zones are both horizontal layers and subvertical targets . . . For example, line . . . crosses both these geometric types of conductive zones . . . In the central part of Block 12, the VTEM results have defined conductive zone . . . The conductive zone is represented by a horizontal (stratiform) layer which lies at ~ 100m depth."

The Company will issue additional news releases as insights into the potential of the Company's properties are provided by our consultants.
