Update on Company's Stewart Project, British Columbia

Auramex Resource Corp. (the "Company") has retained Paul Cartwright, P. Geo., of Pacific Geophysical Ltd. to evaluate and prioritize some of the 109 electromagnetic ("em") anomalies listed and rated by Geotech Ltd., in their interpretation of the \$232,000 helicopter flown VTEM-M Survey that was reported in a news release dated November 19, 2009. Some positive preliminary comments are as follows:

At Tide North, a large area of anomalous airborne em response occurs over a length of 1,000 metres where work in previous years identified anomalous gold values at surface within this zone. Ground geophysical coverage is recommended prior to establishing diamond drilling priorities. Tide North consists of 1,668 hectares, 40 kilometres north of Stewart, and is 100% owned by the Company.

At the Bear Property, several very promising zones of anomalous em are interpreted to be present. One promising zone defined by five of the highest Geotech ratings has a combined extent of 600 metres. Ground based follow-up is recommended at this location next summer, prior to diamond drilling, as warranted.

There are numerous other anomalous areas that appear promising, where ground follow-up and/or drilling will be required to determine the mineral potential.
