## **17.9% Copper Assay on Georgie River Property**

Analyses from approximately 40% of stream sediment samples and 20% of rock assays have been returned from the Company's recently completed exploration program on the Stewart project referred to in a news release of July 20, 2006. Thirty samples returned from stream sediments were anomalous in gold, of which twelve were strongly anomalous in gold, including three from adjoining drainages on the Tide North property from a recently deglaciated area with no previously known mineralization. Detailed prospecting will be carried out in these streams.

Chip and grab sample assays returned to date include more than 20 samples highly anomalous in gold, silver and/or copper, including one assay from a grab sample taken from the 1.1 metre vein mentioned in the July 20, 2006 news release that returned 17.9% copper and 0.96 grams per tonne gold. Systematic chip samples will be taken across the exposed areas of the vein.

Many other showings have been sampled with results from more than 200 chip and grab samples pending. The bulk of the showings sampled have been silicified sericitized shear zones with two to five percent sulphides ranging from one to 50 metres in width. Most of the samples have been taken in areas recently exposed by retreating ice and snowfields.

Detailed prospecting of the glacier and icefield edges has found intense porphyry style mineralization in two areas, indicating the probability that two large porphyry style alteration systems are located under the Todd Icefield. Detailed geological mapping and lithochemical surveys are planned to attempt to determine the location of the centre of these porphyry systems.

Dr. Rodney Kirkham, a retired officer of the Geological Survey of Canada, has joined the exploration team in Stewart in his capacity as a consultant to the company. Dr. Kirkham will be working exclusively with the company for the remainder of this phase of the Stewart program.
