## Stewart Property Update

Auramex Resource Corp. (the “Company”) announces that Geotech Ltd. has completed a helicopter borne VTEM-M survey on the Company’s Bear and Tide North properties near Stewart, B.C. Geotech advises that its Time-domain Electromagnetic geophysical system is excellent for locating discrete conductive anomalies as well as mapping lateral and vertical variations in resistivity. The previously announced option to acquire 1,136 hectares (August 19<sup>th</sup> news release) provides a strategic link joining the Bear and Surprise claim blocks and allows credits from the Bear property to be applied to keep strategic areas of both properties in good standing. Approximately 938 kilometres were flown on the Bear and 115 on Tide North.

Geotech’s interpretation of the data from the 1,053 line-kilometres of helicopter traverses has not yet been received, and additional interpretation by Auramex consultants may be sought. If favourable targets are identified, they will require further evaluation by diamond drilling.

Auramex’ large Bear claim block adjoins to the southeast the Red Cliff property of Mountain Boy Minerals (MTB-V) and Decade Resources Ltd. (DEC-V) with recently announced drill results on the Montrose Zone, including 7.34 grams/tonne gold over 28.35 metres in hole DDH-Mon-2009-3. The zone is thought to be 20 to 30 metres wide and trends northwest and southeast towards Auramex claims. The recent VTEM-M survey covered this area.
