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AURAMEX DISCOVERS GOLD OCCURRENCE

Auramex announces a previously unknown gold bearing vein, exposed by retreat of a glacier on its 100% owned Ashwood property, 20 kilometres south of Stewart, B.C., within the Georgie River claim block. The vein was discovered during the 2011 exploration season by consultant Paul Metcalfe, Ph.D., P. Geo., and described in his assessment report dated January 6, 2012. The report states in part:

“The most encouraging values were returned from the Gamebreaker showing...a west-southwest dipping, shear-hosted quartz+sulphide breccia exposed for 10 m along strike with a maximum true thickness of 1.45 m. The hanging wall and to a lesser extent, the foot wall are also mineralized.”

Acme Laboratories assayed 16 samples using Aqua Regia digestion and ICP-MS finish. The best results are as follows:

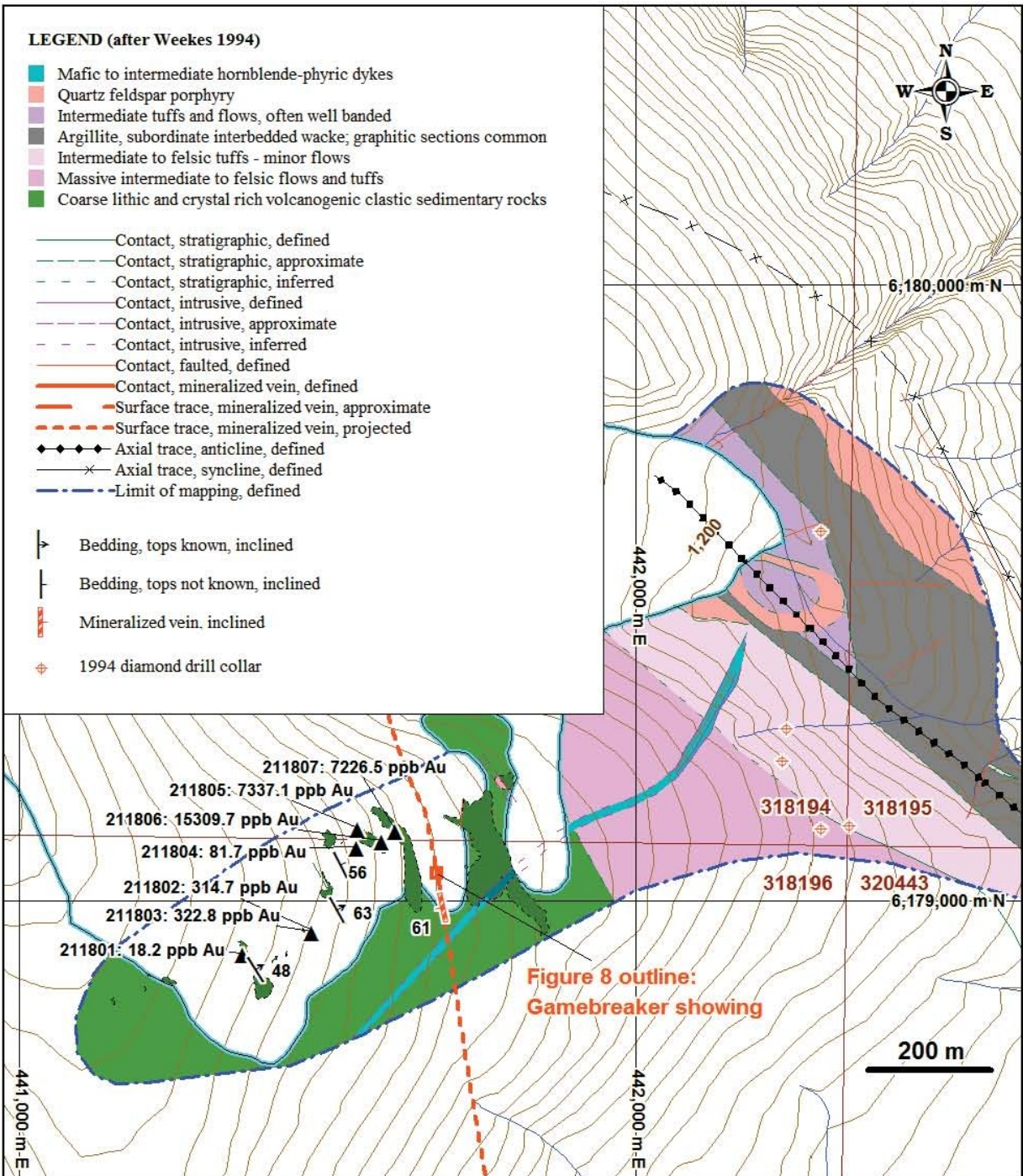
