**Auramex announces successful completion of Bear River RadarSat-1 survey**

Auramex Resource Corp. (“Auramex”) announces preliminary results from the 2015-2016 geophysical surveying carried out on the Company’s Bear River properties north of Stewart, British Columbia. The survey consisted of acquisition of two sets of Fine 6.25m Synthetic Aperture c-band microwave Radar (SAR) data from Canada’s RadarSat-1 satellite and was completed successfully. Auracle Geospatial Science Inc. of Qualicum, B.C. carried out processing of the SAR data using their proprietary technology and methodology. Geological interpretation of the data is ongoing at the time of writing.

Preliminary interpretation of the processed SAR data indicates that the Bear River valley contains structural elements identical to those identified in the field near the Georgia River Mine, 18 km south of Stewart. These structures include folding, southeast-striking shear zones and northerly-striking, steeply-dipping fractures. Shear zones and fractures with these orientations host gold-bearing mineralization at the Georgia River Mine. Properties in the Lower Bear River valley lie along structural strike from several past-producing mineral occurrences and the southeast-striking structures were traced, using the processed SAR data, under the Quaternary gravels of the Bear River. Similarly trending structures were identified on the lower slopes of the Bear Pass area, suggesting a common structural history.

As a consequence of these results, it was recommended that a comprehensive compilation of all geological data relevant to the Bear River properties be carried out at the earliest possible opportunity and fusion of these data with the results of the RadarSat survey to generate a comprehensive, data-driven, information based exploration model for the Bear River valley. This data compilation is in progress at the time of writing.

The geological work has been carried out at Auracle Geospatial Science Inc.’s Qualicum facility by Dr. Paul Metcalfe P.Geo., vice-president of exploration for Auramex and a Qualified Professional under National Instrument 43-101.
